

CHRIST IN YOU THE HOPE OF GLORY

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I. Colossians 1:25-29-Christ in you the Hope of Glory

- A. The riches of the glory-The abundant excellence, magnificence of this mystery
 - 1. Riches-wealth, abundance of external possessions, fulness, abundance, plenitude, a good i.e. that with which one is enriched
 - 2. Glory-In the NT always a good opinion concerning one, resulting in praise, honor, and glory; splendour, brightness, magnificence, excellence, preeminence, dignity, grace, a most glorious condition, most exalted state
- B. This is the great mystery: Christ in you the hope of glory
 - 1. Christ (1 Corinthians 1:24)
 - a. The Greek translation of the Hebrew Word *Masiah*, which means the anointed one.
 - b. It refers to pouring or smearing sacred oil on a person in a ceremony of dedication symbolizing divine empowering to accomplish a task
 - c. *Christ* is the English term for the Greek word *Khristos*, which means *the anointed*.
 - d. *Khristos* was used to translate the Hebrew word *Masiah* which means *one who is anointed*.
 - e. *Khristos* means covered in oil and is the literal translation of *Messiah*.
 - f. The single title *Christos* is used to signify the One who by His Holy Spirit and power indwells believers
 - g. Our English Word *christen* means baptize or submerge.
 - 2. Hope-Confident expectation
 - 3. Glory-Magnificence, Excellence, grace, most exalted state, the manifested goodness (Exodus 33), miracles (Numbers 14:21), manifested word (John 1:14)
 - 4. With the anointed on and his anointing in you, you can confidently expect to a magnificent, excellent life with the manifested goodness of God and word of God in it, where you are at you're most exalted state which means you're living life to the fullest
- C. He wants you to know this mystery intimately and understand it fully (Colossians 2:2)
 - 1. Ephesians 1:16-22
 - a. He wants you to know intimately and understand and experience the surpassing massiveness of this explosive, miracle working, supernatural power that is in you who believe
 - b. That power was demonstrated in the anointed one when he raised him from the dead and set him far above all evil
 - c. Far above all power-There's no power out there that's greater than the power in me

II. You can't win without the anointed one and his anointing working in your life (2 Corinthians 2:14)

- A. Colossians 2:6-7, 3:3-4-This anointing is your life
 - 1. 2:6,7-Walk in that anointing and be rooted in it
 - 2. 2:10-You're complete in that anointing
 - 3. 2:20-If you're separated with the anointed one and his anointing from why do you still live subject to natural law
 - 4. 3:4-The anointed and his anointing is your life because without it you can't win, you can't walk free from the curse, you can't walk in victory that Jesus provided
 - a. A life lived apart from the anointing is one that's unprofitable to you and to others around you
- B. John 15:5-Without his anointing working in your life you can do nothing
 - 1. We got to get a revelation that our success in life hangs on our ability and willingness to do whatever it takes to walk in this anointing
 - a. We need to develop since of necessity and "have to have it" where the anointing is concerned
 - 2. Jesus he isn't every going to leave you; his anointing working in your life is conditional
 - a. A lot of people have Jesus, but don't have his anointing working in their lives
- C. Philippians 3:3-You should place no confidence in your natural ability to get the job done
 - 1. 3-We have no confidence in the flesh; we can't depend on our natural ability
 - a. Because he knew he couldn't depend on his natural ability, he saw the anointing as a vital necessity
 - 2. 4-If anybody thinks they should rely on the flesh nobody has more of a right to think that than me
 - 3. 5-Those things that were a gain to me before were costing me the anointed one and the anointing that was on him so I got rid of them
 - 4. 8-The anointed one and his anointing was so important to me that I gave everything up for it
 - 5. 9-I want to be found in him and in his anointing
 - 6. 10-I want to know him and his anointing and the power that out flowed from his resurrection which is Christ in me the hope of glory
 - 7. To him this was the most important thing in his life
 - a. Without it you're a fruitless Christian and if you aren't bearing fruit the Father gets no glory (John 15:8)
- D. The anointing is the ability to do anything possible or impossible; it's the ability to win in "impossible" situations (Philippians 4:13)
 - 1. Which not who because it's not exactly Jesus who is strengthening you, it's the (which) that was on the who that's strengthening you
- E. You got to get hungry for this anointing; you got to get thirsty for it

III. The anointing of God is the power of the anointed One working in a man, on a man, and in man's life producing victory and God's best

- A. The anointing is supernatural power that produces supernatural results
 - 1. The anointing is a divine empowerment to succeed
 - 2. The anointing is necessary if you expect to win in life
 - 3. The anointing is the ability to win, when you're not supposed to win
 - 4. The anointing is that which the kingdom of darkness has no answer for
- B. The anointing of God is God's super on your natural giving you supernatural ability to do what you could not do before
 - 1. Matthew 14:24-The anointing made it so a natural man could walk on water
 - 2. Luke 1:35-The anointing made it so a woman with no man could have a child
 - 3. Daniel 3-The anointing made it so three men could get thrown into fiery furnace and be unharmed
 - 4. Daniel 6:22-The power of the anointing shut those lions mouths
 - 5. Romans 4:20-The anointing made it so a 90 year woman with a dead womb could have a baby
 - 6. 1 Samuel 17-The anointing made it so a 17-year old boy could win against a giant
 - 7. Mark 5-The anointing made it so a woman who was sick for 12 years could be healed
 - 8. Judges 6-The anointing made it so 300 men could win against 135,000
 - 9. Mark 4-The anointing made it so Jesus could stop that storm
 - 10. Matthew 14-The anointing made it so that 5000 men could be fed with that boys lunch
 - 11. John 8-The anointing made it so they couldn't kill Jesus
- C. Isaiah 10:27-The anointing is the burden removing, yoke destroying power of God
 - 1. No matter what the burden or what the yoke, it's not too much for the anointing
- D. Your problem is no match for God's power or the anointing
 - 1. Jeremiah 32:17, Genesis 18:14, Numbers 11:23

IV. Satan is the anti-Christ; he's literally the one who's against the anointing

- A. 1 John 4:3-4-Satan is the anti-Christ
 - 1. Antichrist-He's against the anointed one and against the anointing
 - 2. The anointed one and his anointing that is in you is greater than the anti-christ
 - 3. Satan is no match for the anointing
 - a. He can't just show up and trump the anointing
 - b. If the anointing is at work, he can't be
- B. Acts 10:38-Satan has no answer for the anointing
 - 1. God anointed Jesus of Nazareth and he became Jesus Christ, the anointed one
 - 2. Jesus was submerged in the Holy Ghost and power (Matthew 3:16)

- a. Anoint-To smear, to rub over, to spread a liquid, anything smeared, to spread a liquid, to be poured, to pour in anointing, to spread on, to rub in
 - (1) EX: When you rub in lotion, the lotion is there, but you just can't see it; you can see the effects of it because my skin is not dry, but you get see it; likewise when God rubs himself in you, that anointing can't be seen, but the effects can be seen because you're winning life
- b. It's God rubbing and smearing himself on a man giving that man supernatural ability to win
- 3. Satan was overpowering people, but when the anointing showed up the oppression ceased, the anointing overpowered the enemy and he couldn't stop it
 - a. The anointing is the believers trump card
- C. John 14:10-The works that Jesus did were done by the Father/anointing in him
 - 1. What works did he do? (Mark 4,5, Matthew 4,14, John 2,8)
 - a. Yeah but that was Jesus; no it was the Father dwelling in Jesus who did the works
 - 2. He said we could do those works and greater could we do because he went to the Father
 - a. John 16:7-When he went to the Father the same spirit that dwelled in him dwells in us; the same Father/anointing that did the works in him is now in us
 - 3. John 14:16-18-The same spirit that dwelled in Jesus is in you
 - a. This is how Jesus came back to you in the form of the Holy Spirit
- D. Acts 1:5,8
 - 1. You have been baptized with the Holy Ghost and power
 - 2. You didn't get a different anointing, a different Holy Ghost, or a different power
 - 3. Acts 2:4-You were immersed in the Holy Ghost and power and anointing
 - 4. 2 Corinthians 1:21-You are anointed
 - 5. God rubbed himself into you and even though he can't be seen, the effects of it working will be seen in your winning life

V. Faith working by love is the platform necessary for the anointing to work in your life

- A. Matthew 12:29-Satan can't do anything in your life when the anointing is at work and if he wants to do anything in your life, the anointing must be shut off **first**
 - 1. If he wants to spoil life he has to bind you **first** and to bind you he has to get you to turn the anointing off because if it's working you can't be bound
- B. Galatians 5:1-6
 - 1. You stand firm in your freedom, by standing firm in the anointing, and you stand firm in the anointing by standing firm in love and faith
 - 2. 2-The anointed one and his anointing doesn't profit you because you are circumcised

3. 4-If you are trying to be justified by doing good things (the law), then you haven't received Jesus has your Lord and neither he nor his anointing will have effect in your life
4. 6-In the anointed and his anointing Jesus, there is no power, force, or strength in circumcision or uncircumcision, but there is strength there is power and there is force in faith working by love and it's called the anointing
5. The moment you step outside of love and faith that anointing stops working and you can't win
6. Rom 8:14, Hebr 2:15-Fear is the yoke of bondage because it shuts off the anointing

VI. Satan can't overpower the anointing in your life; but if he can muddle up the process of faith working by love that activates the anointing he can keep that anointing from every being turned on in your life (Matt 14:24)

A. Matthew 14:24

1. Peter should have no confidence in his flesh to walk on that water
2. He needs the anointing
3. Jesus gave him his word and in doing so his supernatural power
4. Peter's walking on the water, the anointing is working and Satan can't stop it
5. Satan's whole approach is to get Peter out of love and out of faith so that anointing can't work and then he spoil Peter's life
6. Peter didn't stay in love: Love the Lord with all your mind
7. Peter didn't stay in faith: He had more faith in that wind to knock him down
8. When fear began, the anointing stopped, and he was overpowered by the devil
9. Satan had first get him to shut off that anointing

B. Mark 6:1-6

1. Jesus the anointed one and his anointing would work in Nazareth just like it did every where else
2. 3-They were offended-NO LOVE
3. 6-Unbelief-NO FAITH
4. 5-THERE-The platform of love and faith wasn't prepared for the anointing to work
5. 5-He could do no mighty work-The anointing COULDN'T work there

C. God's able to do in your life according to the power that works in you (Eph 3:14-20)

1. When the power of that anointing in you isn't working by faith and love, then God is very limited in what he can do for you
2. The level of love and faith that you are developed to determines the level of anointing that you have working in your life and in turn determines how much God is doing in your life
3. People who are highly developed in love and faith will see God doing a lot in their lives (Daniel 3:16)
 - a. 17-Here's the faith

- b. 18-Here's the love
- c. 19-This was an intimidation tactic of the enemy to try to get them out of love and faith
- d. 25-The anointing showed up

D. Luke 8:41-50

1. 46-He recognized when the anointing left him
2. 42-Jairus needs supernatural ability to get supernatural results
3. 49-This is an intimidation tactic of the enemy to get Jairus out of love and faith
4. 50-Victorious living lies in this statement: Fear not, believe only
 - a. Fear not-1 John 4:18
 - b. Believe only-Faith
5. Jesus was the anointed one and he carried the anointing, but he knew the platform had to be prepared
 - a. 52-Fear
 - b. 53-Unbelief
 - c. That's why he kicked them out
6. Jairus' job was to do the fearing not and the believing only; the anointing's job was to make her whole
 - a. If you do the fearing not and believing only SHE WILL be made whole
 - b. It's been predetermined that if you'll live a lifestyle of love and faith YOU WILL rich you're most exalted state and you're most glorious condition

E. Fear not and believe only is the process by which we reach our most exalted state

VII. Satan's whole work in the life of any believer is base on getting that believer to come outside of love and outside of faith

A. 1 John 3:23-It's no wonder now that this is the commandment to the church

1. Believe on the name
 - a. Revelation 19:13-His name is called the Word of God
2. Love another as he gave commandment
3. He commanded you to do that so that you'd walk in the anointing and not be oppressed by the devil-It's a love letter from Heaven and it's for your good

B. Scriptural examples of love and faith

1. Ephesians 1:15-I've heard of your faith and love
2. Ephesians 6:23-Love with faith from God
3. Colossians 1:4-We've heard of your love and faith
4. 1 Thessalonians 1:3-Work of faith and labor of love

5. 1 Thessalonians 3:6-Told us good tidings about your faith and love
 6. 1 Thessalonians 5:8-Breastplate of faith and love
 7. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-Exceeding faith, abounding love
 8. 1 Timothy 1:5-The end of the commandment is love and faith
 9. 1 Timothy 2:15-Continue in faith and love
 10. 2 Timothy 1:13-Hold fast to sound words in faith and love
 11. Philemon 5-We've heard of your faith and love
- C. Faith works by love to connect to the anointing which removes the burden and destroys the yoke and takes you to your most exalted and glorious state
1. Ephesians 1:19, 3:16, Romans 1:16, John 20:29, Hebrews 4:2
 2. Faith is a fully persuaded uncompromising stand that the Word of God is true
 - a. Faith is thinking, talking, and acting like the Word is true inspire of circumstances that are saying others wise
 3. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word (Romans 10:17)
- D. Love energizes and empowers faith to connect to that anointing; without love in place, faith can't do it's job and you can't connect/activated the anointing
1. James 3:16-Where's there's strife there's no love, no faith, no anointing and consequently every evil work
 2. 2 Timothy 3:1-6-No love, no faith = Form, but no power
 3. 1 Corinthians 3:3-Because of your strife you live as mere men
 4. 2 Timothy 2:24-The servant of the Lord must not strive because he needs the anointing
- E. Stop giving place to the devil (Ephesians 4:26)
1. 1 John 5:18-Keep yourself in love and faith and the wicked one touches you not
 2. Isaiah 54:14-You'll be far from oppression because you do not fear and when you're not in fear you'll be in love and faith where the anointing is working and the oppressor can't

VIII.Living in victory

- A. 2 Corinthians 12:5
1. 7-He's being tormented and that torment got there through fear (1 John 4:18, 2 Corinthians 11:28)
 2. 8-Now because fear and torment our present the anointing is not working, oppression is staying; he's praying to God but can only do according to the power that works in you
 3. 9-God's telling Paul that my grace is more than enough for you, my anointing is made perfect in your weakness, so get in love and faith and access it
 - a. Paul knew faith and love connected to that grace and that anointing (Romans 1:16, 4:16)
 - b. You stop crying around about this and get in love and faith

4. 9-He rejoices when his problem looks too big and it looks like there's no way out because when he stays in faith the anointing will make him strong
 5. 10-I take pleasure and stand firm when I'm under pressure for the sake of the anointing
 6. Paul has a pride problem, but is not overcome by pride; it's hidden pride, it's the pride of taking the care of those churches
- B. 1 Peter 5:5-11
1. When you operate in pride it's resistant to the anointing, because pride says I can take care of it
 2. You put yourself under the authority of this word in love and faith and God will take you to your most exalted state
 3. 8-The enemy is looking for those who are outside of love and faith
- C. James 4:6-7
1. Submit yourself to God (that's love) and resist the devil (that's faith), the anointing will be there, resist the devil and he'll flee
- D. Isaiah 41-God with me means you're anointed
1. That anointing will cause you to thresh through problems
- E. Philippians 2
1. The name of Jesus is the authority-the badge
 2. The anointing is the power that backs the authority
- F. Psalm 91
- G. Philippians 4:6
