## **BASIC FAITH PRINCIPLES**

### Faith Takes It

## I. Apart from faith there is no victory and we have no means of success (1 Jn 5:4)

- A. People who don't **know and apply** the principles of faith will not live in victory
- B. Every victory in life is given as an act of grace that flowed through your faith

#### II. What is faith? What exactly are we supposed to believe?

- A. Faith is perceiving as real fact what's not yet revealed to the senses (Heb 11:1)
  - 1. <u>Faith</u>-Conviction of the truth or reality of anything
- B. Faith levels
  - 1. Believing in God- His Reality
  - 2. Believing God can-His Ability
  - 3. Believing God will-His Willingness
  - 4. Believing God has done it and he's offering it-His Grace/Faith
  - 5. Believing you have received-Receiving
- C. Faith to receive (Mark 11:23-24)
  - 1. It didn't say believe God can or God will and you'll receive
  - 2. Faith says that I have it at and it's fact when it's not revealed to my senses

## III. Every born again child of God was given the measure of faith (Romans 12:3)

- A. God didn't give me more faith than you (Gal 5:22, 2 Thess 3:2)
- B. That measure of faith has the potential to grow if you spend time hearing the Word of God (Romans

10:17)

- No Word = No Faith = No Victory---Little Word = Little Faith = Little Victory; A lot of Word = A lot of Faith = A lot of Victory
  - a. The amount of victory that we see in your life can be traced back to the amount of Word that you spend time with
  - b. What will you do with that truth? (Proverbs 13:13)
- 2. You can't have big faith and spend not time in the Word; that violates spiritual law
- 3. Defeat comes by spending time with the wrong words (Gen 3, Num 13, Mt 14)
- C. Double-minded, non-persuaded faith won't receive from God (James 1:8)
  - 1. The only way to develop your faith to this place of full persuasion and see victory manifest in your life is through time spent in the Word
  - 2. You got to spend so much time with this word that when an evil report comes there's something inside of you convicting about what's really real

# IV. The first greatest deceptions where faith is concerned in the church today is people putting off till tomorrow what God said put on today

- A. As long as you believe something is going to happen you haven't believed you've received anything;
  you believe you're going to receive
  - 1. To believe you're going to be something you have to believe you're not
  - 2. To believe you're going to have something you have believe that you don't have it
- B. Proverbs 23:7-It didn't say as a man thinks he's going to be, he will be
- V. People asking for things that God's already offering; so instead of believing that they have received it they're asking for it
  - A. This is a **grace-faith system** and everything that you receive from God will be given by grace and received through faith (Rom 4:16, 5:2, Eph 2:8)
    - 1. We've had the wrong picture; the picture we've had is that God has it and we don't and we got to ask Him for it because He's not offering it
    - 2. Your were saved by grace through faith (Eph 2:8, Rom 10:8-10)
      - a. You didn't work to earn salvation; Jesus paid the price for salvation and he offered it to you by grace and you had to receive through faith
      - b. You can believe God can save, will save, is offering salvation, and die and go to hell; you have to believe you receive salvation
      - c. You didn't ask for salvation; you placed a demand on the salvation that God was offering; You took the salvation that God was offering
      - d. You didn't confess he was going to be your Lord
  - B. 2 Peter 1:4-Why are we asking for that which is being offered or given?
    - 1. Ephesians 1:3, Galatians 3:13-If he bought me out of the curse, I'm out
    - 2. 1 John 4:17-As he is so are we in this world
    - 3. You are a joint heir with Jesus (Rom 8:17, John 16:15, Heb 1:2, Luke 15)
      - a. You don't ask for your inheritance; you do what's necessary to receive it
      - b. You don't get your inheritance when you die, you get it when he died and you received him as Lord
      - c. The day you got born again there was a deposit made into your account with everything that you would ever need that pertains to life and godliness and God put it there by grace
  - C. John 15:7,16:23-Ask (Aieto) To be adamant in requesting and demanding assistance to meet tangible needs, to demand, insist, require, call for
    - 1. You place a demand on it and take it by believing you have received

- 2. When you believe that you have received you are demanding that what's yours in the unseen, manifest in the seen realm
- 3. EX-When you go to the bank to get money you take the steps necessary to make the withdrawal. You're placing a demand on what's already yours. You don't ask for your money, it's yours
- 4. Mark 11:24
  - a. What things you aiteo (require, demand,) believe that you take them and you will have them
- D. Once you have believed you received there's no more asking (Phil 4:6)
  - 1. If you really have believe that you have received it's seen most in your words and in your attitude (Rom 15:13)
  - 2. You thank God like it's already done because you believe you received it
    - a. You keep your faith engaged through thanksgiving
    - b. Psalm 8:2-This is the praise that stills the avenger
    - c. Joshua 6:2,16
  - 3. Through faith and patience be consistent and receive (Heb 6:12)
- E. The trying of your faith is coming (1 Peter 1:7)
