## YEILD OR RESIST

## You Resist The Devil

## I. Js4:7-The devil will only flee from you, when YOU resist him

- A. Js4:7-The understood subject is YOU; YOU resist the devil; God's not going to resist the devil for you
  - 1. 1Pt5:8-9-He told you to be aware and on the watch because you're are doing to resist Him
- B. God told you to do this and so you're can't pray to Him and get Him to do it for you
  - 1. This verse didn't say to pray and ask God to do something about the devil
  - 2. SAY: God is not going to resist the devil for me
- C. You don't pray the devil away, you resist Him away
  - 1. Many try to pray the pressure off and pray the devil away People like to pray instead of resist b/c that requires they do nothing and God does everything.
- II. Matt4:4-11-The devil fled from Him so whatever see Jesus do in these verses we know is Jesus resisting
  - A. 3-He's being tempted/attacked by the devil What does Jesus need to do? He needs to resist
    - 1. We need to pay close attention here and not try to reinvent the wheel Whatever worked for Jesus will work for us
  - B. 4,7,10-Jesus responded not by addressing God in prayer, but by addressing the the enemy in faith
    - 1. When under attack, when under pressure whom did Jesus address? Whom should you address?
    - 2. So many under pressure, under attack are only addressing God in prayer and NEVER address the enemy
    - 3. It did not say, "So Jesus prayed to the Father and cried out for help."
  - C. What did resistance look like with Jesus? Faith in the Word Of God and the Word of God coming out his mouth
    - 1. 1Pet5:9-Resist him steadfast in faith Faith is believing, acting, speaking like the Word is true no matter what I see/feel This
      is resisting him
    - 2. Faith and resisting To agree with God puts me in a position of resistance to him
      - a. In opening His mouth and speaking the Word he was agreeing with God and resisting the devil
- III. 2Cor12:7-When the enemy attacks whom should you address?
  - A. God did not send Satan to help Paul keep from getting in pride
    - 1. Js1:8-Revelation of God, revelation His Word is going to lift you up every area of your life
    - 2. 1Pt5:6-God is not only not against you being exalted, you is the one who will exalt you
    - $_{\rm 3.}$  Mk4:14-Satan comes immediately to steal the Word so that it doesn't exalt you
  - B. 7-2Cor11:28-The thorn in the flesh was the care of the churches
    - 1. Mark 4:19-Cares entering in choke the word, choke the abundance of revelations
  - C. It was a messenger of Satan to buffet (strike, punch, punish) What are you supposed to do with the enemy? Resist Him
    - 1. 1Pt5:9-Resist him steadfast in faith; Js4:7-Resist him; Eph4:27-Give him no place; Mt4:4-Jesus resisted Him
    - 2. Luke10:19-We've been given authority by Jesus over the enemy
  - ${\sf D.} \quad {\sf 8-He \ asked \ God \ to \ do \ something \ about \ the \ devil- \ Is \ that \ what \ he's \ supposed \ to \ do? \ Is \ that \ resisting \ the \ devil?}$ 
    - 1. The enemy is attacking him so why is he addressing the Lord? Is this what Jesus did?
    - 2. Did this get rid of the devil? No; Do you get the devil to flee from you by asking God to do something?
  - E. 9-God said to Him This is not an encouragement to just hold on tight in your suffering, this is a correction
    - 1. If he had done the right thing God would have just gotten rid of the devil for Him and not said anything
    - 9-10-Why would the power of Christ even need to rest upon HIM? Why would HE need to be strong? Because HE is going to do the resisting; If God was going to do everything, then he could just be weak
  - F. 9-10-These are statements of faith, this is agreeing with God, this is resisting the devil

- IV. Resisting the devil is a concept most believers know nothing about; Their first move under pressure is to pray and ask God to do something and the reason is because they don't believe they have authority over the devil
  - A. Many of my people are praying to me, but very few of them are resisting the devil
    - 1. People have tried to use the prayer of petition for everything and they try to pray the devil away, they try to pray pressure off and they get no results
    - 2. Asking God to do something is not resisting the devil (Example: If he's over here pushing me and I turn to you and ask you to do something about him, asking you to do something about him is not me resisting Him)
    - 3. Many are doing the same thing crying to God, begging God That's acting like you have no authority
  - B. Eph4:26-You have authority over the devil to resist him and see him flee, to give him no place
    - 1. You have authority over evil thoughts, wrong feelings and you need exercise you're God-given authority
    - 2. God please do something about these thoughts, these feelings about this; EX: He's giving you joy and authority over depression What do you want to do?
