CALLING THINGS THAT BE NOT AS THOUGH THEY ARE

We Call Things That Be Not As Though They Are

- I. God calls things that be not as though they are-Rm4:17-As it is written, I have made thee the Father of many nations, before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead and <u>calls those things which be not as though they were;</u> ER-As the scriptures say, "I have made you a father of many nations." This is true before God, the one Abraham believed—the God who gives life to the dead and <u>speaks of things that don't yet exist as if they are real;</u> AC-Speaks of nonexistent things that [He has foretold and <u>promised</u>] as if they already existed; DLNT-Calling the <u>things not being as being</u>; JUB-Calls those things <u>which are not as those that are;</u> TL-Speaks of future events with as much certainty as though they were already past
 - A. This is scripture is referring to God calling Abraham the father of multitudes when that didn't exist-*Gn17:2-I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.* ³ And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, ⁴ As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. ⁵ Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram (exalted father), but thy name shall be Abraham (father of a multitude); for a father of many nations have I made thee.
 - 1. You can be something that you don't see yet-God made him the father of many nations and yet he can't see it
 - a. Things can be true that haven't happened yet-Rm4:17-WE-He believed God when he said that things were true even though they had not happened yet
 - b. God can give you something you don't see yet-Nm27:12-The land which I have given unto the children of Israel
 - 2. God changed his name and is calling him something that does not yet exist-In the natural he is not the Father multitudes, that does not exist and yet God calls Him that (when that doesn't exist)
 - 3. God is telling Abraham what to call himself and what He's telling him to call himself, in the natural, he is not-lt wasn't just that God was calling Him this, Abraham was calling himself what God called him that did not yet exist
 - B. <u>Calling things that be not as though they are is the way God operates-</u>As much as our God is a God who quickens the dead is as much as He is a God who calls things that be not as though they are; This is just who He is, how he operates
 - 1. God looks at something that isn't what He wants it to be and calls it what He wants it to be so that it will be-Rm4:17-EHV-Calls non-existing things so that they exist
 - 2. God saw darkness, but called light-*Gn1:1*-In the beginning God created the Heaven and the Earth. And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. 3 And God said, Let there be light.
 - 3. God called Gideon a mighty man of valour-*Jd6:12*-The Lord is with thee, you mighty (warrior, champion) man of valor (strength of mind in regard to danger, courage, bravery)
 - 4. God saw them dying in their own blood and said live-*Ez16:6*-When I passed by thee, and saw thee polluted in thine own blood, I said unto thee, when you were in your own blood, Live; yea, I said unto thee when you were in your own blood live
 - 5. God spoke to dry bones through the prophet-*Ez37:4-*Prophesy upon these bones and say unto them, O ye dry bones hear the word of the Lord 5 Thus saith the Lord God unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you and you shall live
 - 6. God called Jericho was theirs-Js6:2-I have given into your hand Jericho, the king thereof and the mighty men of valor
 - C. Jesus called things that be not as though they were-When we've seen Him we've seen the father-Co1:15, Jn5:19,14:9
 - 1. Peace was not, but he called it-Mk4:39-He arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still
 - 2. <u>She was not loosed, but Jesus called her loosed</u>-She was not loosed when he said that, but he called here what she wasn't so she could be what she wasn't-*Lk13:11-12*-Behold there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in now wise lift up herself 12... Woman, you are loosed from thine infirmity
 - 3. He was not clean, but Jesus called him clean-Mt8:3-Jesus put forth is hand and touched him saying, I will; be thou clean
 - 4. <u>Jesus called his ears opened-Mk7:34-Looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is Be opened</u>
 - 5. <u>Jesus called it the way he believed, when it was not that way-Mt8:13-</u>As you have believe so be it done unto you

- 6. <u>If God calls things that be not as though they are and Jesus only says what the Father says, then Jesus will call things that be not as though they are-Jn3:34-For he whom God has sent speaks the Words of God; Jn8:28-As my father hath taught me, I speak these things; Jn12:50-Whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me so I speak</u>
- 7. <u>If God calls things that be not as though they are and we say what God says, then when too will call things that be not as thought they are-</u>If you're going to talk like God you're going to call things that be not as though they are

II. We are to call things that be not as though they are

- A. <u>We should conduct ourselves the way Jesus conducted himself</u>-Religion is fine with you being like Jesus morally, but they choke when you conduct yourself the way he did-1Jn2:6-AC-Whoseover says he abides in Him ought to walk and conduct himself in the same way in which He walked and conducted himself; Lk6:40-The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master; Eph5:1-Be ye therefore followers (imitators) of God, as dear children
- B. We do not have the capability to just call whatever we want into existence-We don't have creative ability like God Many have dismissed these scriptures and this teaching because they think that's what we are saying
- C. <u>If God has said something to us, something about us, promised us something that doesn't exist we can call that into existence based on His Word-</u>It's not us calling whatever we want, but discovering what God's will is and declaring it
 - 1. When Jesus taught us how to pray he taught us to call God's will into being-Mt6:10-Thy will be done
 - 2. <u>Abraham can't just call himself the Father of multitudes and see it happen, but because God said it, he can say it-</u>
 It's things He has foretold and promised that we call into existence
 - 3. <u>It's not us causing it to happen, it's the Father who does the work-</u>We are speaking the Words, He does the work
 - 4. <u>I can take His Word and frame my world with my words-*Hb11:3-Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear*</u>
- D. If God has said something about you that does not exist in the natural what do you do?-You call it into being based on what God has said When you know something is God's will for your life and you don't see it you call it
 - 1. Keith Moore stories-Man smoking cigarettes saying, "I can't get free." I'm free from nicotine
 - 2. The challenging thing for the flesh is you have to call it this way when it's not this way
