How To Believe & Speak: Choose To Believe

- I. Jesus is teaching us to use our words and our faith to accomplish something-He is teaching us we can believe and speak to physical things and see them change-*Mk11:22*-Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³ For verily (truly, surely, truth) I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith
 - A. <u>Believing and speaking is a spiritual law</u>-God established the spiritual law of believing and speaking
 - 1. <u>Law-Str</u>-Principle (a truth); <u>Th</u>-Anything established; Laws are simply how things work-It's established you do this, this is the result; <u>Spiritual law</u>-A statement by God that a particular phenomenon always occurs if certain conditions be present
 - B. <u>Spiritual law. spiritual things work a certain way</u>-There's a way believing and speaking works and a way it doesn't; The devil and the children of Israel tried it and it didn't work-Is14,Nm14; Jesus spoke to the storm and it did work-Mk4
 - 1. Prayer works a certain way-There are things you can do that'll cause prayer to work or not work-Mt21:22,1Jn5:14
 - 2. Peace works a certain way-There are things you can do that'll cause peace to work or not work-Rm8:5; Is26:3
 - C. How do we believe and speak and see it work? -He didn't say it'll work some of the time; It worked all the time for Him
 - 1. If we want to see spiritual laws work, we have to make sure we work the law-Things must be in place for it to work
 - 2. Anytime it didn't work it was because you lacked light-There was something you didn't see about its working

II. How to believe and speak: #2. I choose to believe what God says about my situation – Once you discover what God says about your situation, God's will for your situation, choose to believe what He says

- A. <u>If you don't believe what God says you won't say what He says</u>-I have to believe what God says before I can say what He says and believe that what I say will come to pass-*2Cor4:13-I have believed and therefore have I spoken*
- B. Faith is a choice-Ps91:2-In him will I trust; Is7:9-If you will not believe, surely you shall not be established
 - 1. <u>He corrected them about their unbelief because they chose not to believe</u>-*Mk16:14*-Upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen; *TL*-Stubborn refusal to believe
 - 2. How do you have faith in God-By decision
- C. <u>You activate your faith with your will and your words</u>-When you say, I choose to believe that, and mean business you just activated your faith-*Ps56:3-I will trust in you; Ps61:4-I will trust in the covert of thy wings; Hb2:13-I will put my trust in him*
 - 1. <u>Thomas activated his unbelief with is will and words-</u>*Jn20:25-*The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe 27 Be not faithless (Incredulous-Withholding or refusal of belief) but believing
 - 2. Your faith isn't activated until you choose to believe-Before you choose to believe faith lays dormant
 - 3. <u>You believe on purpose</u>-You don't believe just because you want to or know you should; You don't believe until you choose to believe; Many never believe because they didn't decide to
 - 4. Faith has to be activated in each area-Ac14:9-Perceiving he had faith to be healed
 - 5. Story: Going through the pandemic we chose to believe-Ps91,Ps37
- D. You choose to believe The Word in spite of what you see and feel-Hb11:1-Faith is...the evidence of things not seen
- E. <u>To keep your faith on you have to uphold and maintain that decision and if you don't faith shuts off</u>-Making the decision is to believe is quick and easy, maintaining it is a fight
- F. <u>Faith comes by hearing, but it happens by decision</u>-You can hear and not have faith if you don't choose to believe-*Rm10:17-So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. 18 But I say have they not heard?...19 But I say, Did*

not Israel know?... 21 But to Israel he saith, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a disobedient (disbelieve willfully, not allow one's self to be persuaded, to refuse or withhold belief) and gainsaying people

- 1. <u>Faith doesn't happen just because you hear-Many think if I just hear it enough eventually I'll believe it</u> unconsciously – WRONG – You might eventually choose to believe it, but not without a decision
- 2. <u>The more you hear something the more likely you are to choose to believe it</u>-But faith never happens without a decision
- G. <u>You must mix The Word you've heard with faith or The Word will never profit you</u>-*Hb4:2*-For unto us was the gospel preached as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in that theard it
 - 1. <u>The profit is in the mixture</u>-Hearing The Word or just knowing what it says, won't cause the Word to profit you
 - 2. You can hear it and know it and not mix it with faith and it'll do nothing for you-Story-Jer29:11 sign in my office
