

## **GOD WANTS ME WELL – We Prayed & It Didn't Happen – Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup>**

- **We don't discern the will of God by our prayers & the results they do/don't produce-**  
*Mt17:14*-When they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying, Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatic, and sore vexed: for oftimes he falls into the fire, and oft into the water. And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him. Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him hither to me. And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour
- They disciples prayed and he didn't get healed-Did this prove healing wasn't the will of God for Him? It couldn't have because seconds later Jesus prayed and He got healed
- Just because someone prayed and didn't get healed that doesn't speak to God's will- Many believe because they prayed for someone who didn't get healed, that proves that healing is not the will of God for everybody
- Examples-If we pray for someone to be delivered from depression and they don't get it does that prove that deliverance from depression wasn't the will of God for them? If we pray for unborn babies to not be aborted and some are does that mean it wasn't the will?
- **An experience doesn't determine the will of God and it doesn't change who God is**
  - People have an experience and they think that speaks to who God is and what His will is
  - Not receiving healing doesn't change who God is-It doesn't change His nature, will, word
- **If God always wants to heal why doesn't He? God's not doing everything He wants in everybody's life on the Earth; There's all kinds of things happening on this earth that aren't the will of God-***2Pt3:9*-God is not willing that any perish, but that all should come to repentance
  - Healing like every promise must be received-People don't receive the promises of God for a myriad of reasons; It doesn't make them a bad person and it doesn't mean it wasn't God's will
  - COI failed to possess the promise land-Does that mean it wasn't God's will for them?
