

## **WHAT DOES THE WORD SAY? – The Word Is The Answer – Thursday, July 8<sup>th</sup>**

- **God uses His word to help His people-***Ps107:19-Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble and he saves them out of their distresses. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions*
  - When God's people cried out to him for help. He sent His word-He does this with us
  - When you need God's help look to His Word. look for His Word-It is all the help you need
- **There are answers and help in this Bible**
  - This Word is alive and powerful-*Hb4:12-For the word of God is quick and powerful; BBE-The Word of God is living and full of power; Rm1:16-For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God*
  - God's words will bring life to dead situations-*Jn6:63-It is the spirit that quickens (cause to live, strengthen, give life); the flesh profits nothing: the words I speak unto you they are spirit and they are life*
  - The truth of God's word will make you free from anything you need to be free from-*Jn8:31-If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed and you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free;*
  - God's words are life and health to the flesh-*Pr4:20-My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh*
  - God's words are a shield-*Ps91:4-His truth shall be your shield and buckler*
  - Born again by the Word-*1Pt1:23-Born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God*
- **We run to this Word in our time of need because we realize our answer is in here**
  - Many don't run to the Word because they don't believe there are answers in The Word- They don't believe the truth will make them free, they don't believe it's alive and powerful
  - In his time of trouble he ran to the Word and he credits The Word for his victory-*Ps119:92-Unless they law had been my delights, I should then have perished (destroy, fail) in mine affliction (trouble)*
  - EX: When I didn't know how I'd meet my wife-The Word was my answer-*Gn2:22*
