THE DREAM KILLER – How To Walk In The Spirit – Friday, March 5th

- Fleshy desires war against the soul-1Pt2:11-Abstain from fleshy lusts, which war against the soul
 - <u>Tri-part beings</u>-I am a spirit being, I have soul (mind, will, emotions), I live in a body-1Th5:23-The very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ
 - <u>Walking in the flesh starts in the mind. not the body</u>-The enemy brings a carnal thought to you that triggers feelings and even reactions in your body and your body says do it, do it-**Rm8:5-**For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh
- Your spirit is supposed to rule over your mind and body-2Co10:5-Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ; 1Cor9:26-But I keep under <u>my body</u> and bring it into subjection
 - Your mind and body can't be left to themselves-They'll think and do wild things-1Th4:4-Every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honor
 - <u>Spiritual hierarchy</u>-Holy Spirit > My Spirit > Mind > Body-When a thought comes to my
 mind that opposes what I got from the Holy Spirit I'm supposed to cast it down; When my
 body wants to do something that opposes what I got from the Holy Spirit I keep it under
 - You rule with your words and your words are connected to your spirit-Mt12:34-The mind will go where the spirit/words allows it and the body will follow the mind
 - <u>His mind is troubled, his body doesn't want to praise</u>-*Ps42:5*-Why are you cast down (depress), O my soul (seat of thoughts, feelings)? And why are you disquieted (troubled) in me? Hope in God: for I shall yet praise him
- My spirit needs to be strong so it can rule over the mind and body-Ep3:16
 - When my mind and body are trying go the way of the flesh. my spirit rises up-*Pr18:14*-The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity (weakness of mind, body, resolution); but a wounded spirit who can bear
