- God has called every believer to be a part of a local church
 - The Holy Ghost said to the leaders you oversee this portion, you oversee that portion: Which
 portion did He say you don't need oversight and a flock-*Ac20:28*-Take heed therefore unto
 yourselves and to all the flock over the which the Holy Ghost has made you overseers to feed the church of God
 - <u>Churches are God's plan-</u>Churches are made of individual believers-*Acts15:41*-He went through Syria and Cilicia, confirming the churches; *Rm16:4*-Churches of the gentiles; *1Cor16:19*-Churches of Asia; *2Cor8:81*-Churches of Macedonia; *Gal1:2*-Churches of Galatia
- Many have the idea that God doesn't care if I go to church This idea is floating around
 - God cares about me having a relationship with Him, not going to church-Care about 2 things
 - 2 can be true-It is true God wants a relationship w/ you, it's true He wants you to go to church
 - If God doesn't care where are the scriptures-Shouldn't decide what He cares about on your own
 - You don't have to go to church to be saved-True, but you have to go to church to be obedient
 - There has been a concerted effort by the enemy to demean the importance of going to church-He wants to keep people out of church and he has all these zinger phrases
 - So many have the idea that it's okay to forsake what God said don't forsake-*Hb10:25*-Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together as the manner of some is, but exhorting one another
- Going to the church God has called you to is a major key in having a strong spiritual life
 - You receive feeding. fellowship. the opportunity to serve-Ac20:28, Hb10:25, Jn4:34
 - Easy investment that yields a great reward-Things happen in your spirit that you don't realize
 - This is the easiest most basic thing a Christian can do-It's Christianity 101
 - <u>People who can't seem to get over the hump</u>-Same ones who can't seem to get to church
 - Too many Christians are missing too much church
