PLEASING GOD – A HEART TO PLEASE THE LORD – MONDAY

- We are righteous and loved by God This is our condition and position
 - You are righteous-The condition of your spirit is acceptable to God; You are no longer a dead sinner inside-2Cor5:21-For he hath made him to be sin for us who knew no sin, that we might be made the righteousness (condition acceptable) of God in Him
 - <u>God loves you</u>-*Rm5:8*-God commended his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners Christ died for us: *Rm8:37*-We are more than conquerors through Him that loved us
 - In being righteous and loved your conduct does not matter-Nothing you do affects these two-It doesn't make you more righteous or more loved
- You can please the Lord with your conduct
 - When it comes to pleasing the Lord your conduct does matter-1Jn3:22-We keep his commandments and do those things that are pleasing in his sight
 - Over emphasis of grace demeans the importance of our conduct-We're not saved by our works or loved because of what we do, but to please Him conduct matters
- The heart of every believer should be to live in a way that pleases the Lord-Col1:10-This will help you live in a way that brings honor to the Lord and pleases Him in every way
 - Live like Jesus, pleasing God-Jn8:29-I always does those things that are pleasing in His sight
 - <u>Don't stop at being righteous and loved</u>-I'm thankful I'm righteous and loved and that it's separate from what I do, but I don't want to stop there, I want to please Him
 - It's in the make-up of every child to want to please their parents-Want to show Dad
 - <u>Grace & Faith</u>-Nothing they do can ever cause me to love them more or to accept them more, but they can live in such a way that pleases me or grieves me
 - Don't fall into condemnation-If you're not pleasing Him repent and make a change
