## **RESIST THE DEVIL**

## You Have A God Given Responsibility To Resist The Devil

## I. One of the first important things you can learn in this life is your need to resist the devil

- A. As believers it is our God-given responsibility to resist the devil
  - 1. We are told multiple times in The Word to resist the devil
    - a. <u>Resist the devil</u>-Js4:7-Submit to God, resist the devil and He will flee from you; AM-Stand firm against him; CJB-Take a stand against the Adversary; ERV-Stand against the devil; MS-Yell a loud no to the Devil and watch him make himself scarce; VO-Fight against the devil <u>and his schemes</u>
    - b. <u>Resist him steadfast in faith</u>-1Pt5:8-Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: <sup>9</sup> Whom resist steadfast in the faith; AM-But resist him, <u>be firm in your faith [against his attack</u> rooted, established, immoveable]; EXB-Refuse to give in to him; TP-Take a decisive stand against him and <u>resist his every attack</u> with strong, vigorous faith
    - c. <u>Stand against the wiles of the devil</u>-*Eph6:10-KJ-*Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. <sup>11</sup> Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be <u>able to stand against the wiles (plans, schemes, tricks) of the devil</u> (*PH*-So that you can successful resist all the devil's methods of attack). <sup>12</sup> For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. <sup>13</sup> Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand (resist) in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. <sup>14</sup> Stand therefore; *AM*-Therefore, put on the complete armor of God, so that you will be able to [successfully] resist and stand your ground in the evil day [of danger], and having done everything [that the crisis demands], to stand firm [in your place, fully prepared, immovable, victorious].
  - 2. We are resisting him and anything he tries to do in our lives
- B. God does not resist the devil for us
  - 1. <u>God told us to be on the watch for him because we are the ones who resist him-1Pt5:8-Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: <sup>9</sup> Whom resist stedfast in the faith</u>
  - 2. <u>God told us to be strong because we are the ones who resist him</u>-*Eph6:10-KJ-Be strong in the Lord, and in the power* of his might. <sup>11</sup> Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. <sup>13</sup> Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand (resist) in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- C. If you enjoy victory over the enemy in your life, it'll be because you resist him
  - 1. You will not see the devil flee from you until YOU start resisting him
  - 2. Other people's prayers will not cause the devil to flee from you
  - 3. Nobody can resist the devil for you
