Hardened To Difficulties

- I. The ability to be content no matter the circumstance is the definition of strength-Ph4:11-Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. ¹² I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: everywhere and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. ¹³ I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me.
 - A. The circumstances don't affect vou-This means you're strong
 - B. <u>His strong spirit enabled him to be content-</u>Content-Independent of external circumstances; W1828-A mind at peace, not disturbed in the present condition
 - C. When you're going through hell, but you still have your faith, peace and joy this is being strong-Col1:11-Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness; AC- [We pray] that you may be invigorated and strengthened with all power according to the might of His glory, [to exercise] every kind of endurance and patience (perseverance and forbearance) with joy; ISV-You are being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might, so that you might patiently endure everything with joy; TLB-We are praying, too, that you will be filled with his mighty, glorious strength so that you can keep going no matter what happens—always full of the joy of the Lord; VO-Strengthen them with Your infinite power, according to Your glorious might, so that they will have everything they need to hold on and endure hardship patiently and joyfully.
- II. When you're strong you're hardened to difficulties and that means difficulties don't affects you-Is41:10-AC-Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror and be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you
 - A. None of these things move me-Acts20:22-And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: ²³ Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me. ²⁴ But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.
 - B. Paul had tapped into the strength of God to the place where he was hardened to difficulties-2Co4:8-We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair 9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; 17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory
