RESIST THE DEVIL

It's Not All Up To God

I. Passiveness where the devil is concerned will get you devoured

- A. The devil is looking to devour and the way to not be is to resist him—If you don't resist being devoured is all that is left—1Pt5:8—Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: 9 Whom resist steadfast in the faith; TP—Take a decisive stand against him and resist his every attack with strong, vigorous faith
 - 1. Passive-Unresisting, not opposing, not acting, suffering without resistance
- B. <u>If you're passive the devil will succeed against you</u>-Js4:7-Resist the devil and He will flee from you; **VO**-Fight against the devil and his schemes. <u>If you do</u>, he will run away in failure
- C. There are all kinds of things that will devour you if you don't resist them—

 Ep6:11-Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil;

 13 Take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore; MS-Stand up to everything the Devil throws your way

II. The devil works tirelessly to get believers to be passive

- A. One of the devil's strategies is to pass off an idea of his as God
 - 1. Be cautious about (1) Quoting phrases that seem right like they're scriptures and (2) Assuming the majority is right-Pr14:12-There is a way which seems right unto man, but the end therefore is death; Nm13
- B. Through ideas that seem right Satan has seduced many into a passive state
 - 1. <u>"God is in control of everything"</u>—He chose not to be in control of everything on the earth—*Gn1:26*—Let them have dominion (control)
 - a. A lot of stuff God's not controlling—What you resist, think, say, sow, believe Dt30:19—I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life
 - b. The outcomes you experience are directly connected to choices you make -God left the outcome of life/blessing, death/curse in their hands
 - c. <u>Interpretation</u>-If you interpret a verse to say something about God, there should be other verses confirming your interpretation is correct
 - 2. <u>"It's all up to God"</u>-Many think that what happens in their life is all up to God and they have no part in the outcomes they experience-Js1:8-You shall make your way prosperous; Lk8:50-Fear not believe only and she shall be made whole; Mt13:58; Mt17:20
 - a. If truly is ALL up to God then we have no part-Rm8:6, Ga6:8, Pr18:21
 - b. <u>Is it really all to God</u>-Woman with the issue of blood, in Jesus' hometown, The COI possessing the land; Peter walking on the water-Was it all up to God?
 - c. What you do or don't do affects what He can do-So it's not all up to God
 - d. You can't remove yourself from an equation God put you in-Many attempt to remove us from the equation and make God responsible for everything that happens in my life-That's convenient for and pleasing to the flesh
 - 3. <u>"It's by grace alone"</u>—If it truly is grace ALONE, then you have no part—Eph2:8—For by graced are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God
 - a. God does not receive for you-The children of Israel were excited about the land until they learned they had a part to play in receiving it

- b. Thy faith-Mt9:29-According to your faith; Mk5:34-Thy faith has made thee whole
- 4. "Let go & let God"-Let go of the care, but then resist-1Pt5:7-9
 - a. Fight & lay hold-1Tm6:12-Fight the good fight of faith lay hold on eternal life; Mk11:24
- 5. "We are waiting on God"—Is30:18-Therefore will the Lord will wait, that he may be gracious unto you; Js18:3-How long are ye slack to go to possess the land, which the Lord God of your fathers hath given you? Ex14:15-Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: ¹⁶ But lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.
- c. <u>Satan wants to sow something into you to seduce you into a state of passiveness</u>
 -These are not harmless phrases; This is what the devil does
 - 1. The devil wants you to do anything but actively resist Him
- III. We are not to be passive in regards to the devil or anything he tries to do in our lives-1Pt5:8-GN-Be alert, be on watch! Your enemy, the devil, roams around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour 9 Be firm in your faith and resist him
 - A. <u>Be sober, be vigilant, resist</u>-We're not just being, waiting, begging, letting go and letting God Put on the armor and resist
 - B. <u>Live in resistance mode</u>-Be on the watch and when you recognize the devil trying to do something in your life, you go into hardline resistance mode
 - 1. Find out what The Word says and push back against the attack-Call yourself free, cast down every wrong thought that says you're not, expect God to get involved, push back on the devil, believe when I don't see
 - c. Many operate far too passively to enjoy victory over the devil
 - 1. Many believers are not taught to resist-But pray, beg, ask, wait, let go
 - 2. To stand on The Word and in the authority of The Name and and push back against the devil puts you in a very small minority of believers
