What If I'm Not Confident

- I. If you're not confident the answer is NOT to pretend like you are-M9:17-One of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb (mute) spirit; ¹⁸ And wheresoever he taketh him, he <u>TEARETH</u> (epilepsy, seizure, to seize) him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and <u>THEY COULD NOT</u>. ¹⁹ He answereth him, and saith, O <u>FAITHLESS</u> generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? <u>BRING HIM UNIO ME</u>. ²⁰ And they brought him unto him: and <u>WHEN HE SAW HIM, STRAIGHTWAY</u> <u>THE SPIRIT</u> tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming. ²⁰ And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child.²⁰ And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but <u>IF THOU CANST DO ANYTHING</u>, have compassion on us, and help us. ²⁰ Jesus said unto him, <u>IF THOU CANST BELIEVE</u> (have faith, be confident), all things are possible to him that believeth. ²⁴ And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, <u>I</u> <u>BELIEVE; HELP THOU MINE UNBELIEF</u>.⁵...he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. ²⁶ And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him
 - A. <u>God works in our lives according to our faith NOT solely according to His will-</u>This is why it is vitally important that we learn how to get in faith and stay in faith
 - 1. Believing is having faith, being confident, not just wanting something to happen
 - 2. If he doesn't believe it'll limit what God can do-Many get upset at the reality that our faith affects what God can do for us, yet The Master says it right here
 - B. <u>You can want to believe and choose to believe but still lack confidence</u>-It dawned on him he had to get in faith so he made a choice, but he lacked confidence
 - C. <u>2 kinds of unbelief</u>-1.Incredulous/Unwilling to believe-Worst kind-*Jn20:25-<u>I</u>* <u>WILL NOT</u> believe; *Hb3:12-<u>EVIL HEART</u> of unbelief; 2.Weaknesss of faith/lack of confidence-<i>Mt14:31*-Thou of <u>LITTLE FAITH</u> (lacking confidence), wherefore didst thou doubt

II. (1) If you lack confidence humble yourself and ask for help

A. <u>Don't pretend to be confident</u>-Faith isn't pretending to be confident or false bravado – Lord, I know your Word is true, I know you're faithful, but my confidence is low

III. (2) If you lack confidence don't accept not being confident

- A. <u>Faith people are supposed to be confident</u>-Like David, 3 Hebrews, Mark 5 woman, Abraham, Psalm 91
- B. <u>We are supposed to be this way (confident) and it's supposed to be real</u>-Not just speaking so-called "faith words" but rather speaking words with faith in them
- C. You got to get sure because that's where the power is-Weak faith won't get you much
- D. <u>They had form but no faith/confidence/weren't sure</u>-He addressed their heart not their form-Mt17:19-Why could not we cast him out? ²⁰Jesus said unto them, Because of <u>YOUR UNBELIEF</u>: for verily I say unto you, <u>IF YE HAVE FAITH</u> as a grain of mustard seed ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you

IV. You can start out lacking confidence but end up fully persuaded

A. <u>Abraham & Sara</u>-Sara started off laughing and Abraham started off sleeping with Hagar, but both of them got confident-*Gn18:12; Hb11:11; Gn16:4; Rm4:21*
