

**FAITH TO BE HEALED**  
God Is A Healing God

**I. A major key to receiving healing is believing that God is a healing God—You do that by feeding on scriptures about God being a healing God**

You have many saying God is no longer a healing God and healing is not always His will—He says I am The Lord that heals and I will heal you

A. He is The Lord that heals me—Ex15:26—I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the Lord that healeth thee.

1. These are His own words and He introduces Himself as The Lord that heals —You can't see He isn't something He says He is

B. He will take sickness from the midst of me—Ex23:25—I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

1. You can't say something is not God's will when He says, "I will"—Many say he won't or sometimes it's not His will, but these are His own words

C. He will take away from me all sickness—Dt7:15—The Lord will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee

D. He heals all my diseases—There's nothing He can't or won't heal—Ps103:2—<sup>3</sup>Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases

E. He will heal me when I call out to him in faith—In the Bible He never turned anyone away who came for healing (Jairus, Blood woman, Blind men)—Ps30:2—O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me. <sup>3</sup>O Lord, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive...

Let God be who He reveals Himself to be in His Word NOT who people tell you He is

F. He will make me well—Ps41:2—KJ—The Lord will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make his bed in sickness—ER—When they are sick, the Lord will give them strength and make them well

**II. Jesus was a healing Jesus—Mt8:16—He healed all that were sick—Mt12:15—Great multitudes followed him and he healed them all—Lk4:40—All they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them—Lk6:19—The whole multitude sought to touch him; for there went virtue out of him and healed them all**

A. He was the visible representation of the invisible God—Co1:15—AC—[Now] He is the exact likeness of the unseen God [the visible representation of the invisible]

B. He does what He sees the Father do—Jn5:19—The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he sees the Father do: for what things soever he does, these also the Son likewise

C. When you see Him you see the Father—Jn14:9—He that has seen me has seen the father

**III. For God to not heal today He would've had to of changed; When did He change? When did He stop being the Lord that heals you? When did healing stop being His will for His people?—Ma3:6—I am the Lord, I change not**

A. We serve the same God of the Bible—Hb13:8—The same yesterday and today and forever

B. Don't let someone not receiving their healing affect what you believe about God being a God who heals—Or what you believe about God healing you

**IV. Healing is God's will for His people—Lk13:16—Ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?**

A. According to Jesus here lineage gives her right to something—CEV—This woman belongs to the family of Abraham...isn't it right to set her free on the Sabbath? Ga3:29—If you be Christ's then you are Abraham's seed
