### PEACE & JOY IN THE HOLY GHOST

Peace & Joy Give God Access

- I. Fear, sorrow, worry, anger are symptoms (that which indicates the existence of something else) of unbelief-Jn14:1-Let not your heart be troubled (agitate, anxious, distress): you believe in God-Mk4:40-Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith-Mt6:28-Why take ye thought for raiment...30 O ye of little faith-1Th4:13-That ye sorrow (heavy, trouble) not even as others which have no hope (confidence, faith)
  - A. These aren't harmless emotions-Indicate something more serious is at work
- II. Unbelief shuts God out of your life-Mk6:5-He could there do no mighty work save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk and healed them...marvelled because of their unbelief-Mt13:58

Many like to imagine He doesn't b/c He's God He'll do what He wants

- God needs you to give Him access-Rv3:20-I stand at the door and knock: if any man hear my voice and open the door I will come in to him and will sup with him;
- Faith gives him access-Ep2:8-By grace you are saved through faith-2Pt3:9-Not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance

Confidence, trust, yielding, C following

There's a certainway these things work and it's not just by God doing whatever He wants in everybody's life

Spiritual things are real-He could do no mighty work, that's real; Many touched Him wanting something, only the touch of faith conducted the power -Mk5:24-Much people followed him and thronged him. <sup>27</sup>Came in the press behind and touched his garment. <sup>30</sup>Knowing in himself that virtue had gone out of him...said who touched my clothes? <sup>31</sup>Thou seest the multitude thronging thee and sayest thou Who touched me? Is30:15-In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not. <sup>16</sup>But ye said no... <sup>18</sup>And therefore will the Lord wait that he may be gracious unto you-Lk8:50-Fear not believe only and she shall be made whole-Ps78:41

- D. He can lack access to do what He wants-Mt23:37-0 Jerusalem...you that kills the prophets and stones them which are sent unto you, how often would I have gathered thy children together even as a hen gathers her chickens under her wings and ye would not (ER-You did not let me) <sup>38</sup>Behold your house is left unto you desolate
- E. <u>Yielding to fear and sorrow is being faithless and it leaves God on the outside looking in</u>-The devil isn't just trying to get you to have a bad day; He wants you in fear and sorrow because he wants you out of faith where God has no access-You don't want to play with this stuff

# III. Faith expressed in joy and peace gives God access into your life

They couldn't see what God was doing while they were

- A. When they began to sing, God had access-Marching to an army you can't defeat, singing and all you have is God's Word, this is faith-2ch20:22-When they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.
- B. <u>They sand praises and God had access</u>-Arrested, beaten, prison, feet in stock and they sang, this is faith-Ac16:25-At midnight Paul and Silas prayed and sang praises unto God...<sup>26</sup> And suddenly there was a great earthquake...and immediately all the doors were opened...every one's bands were loosed
- C. The spirit of faith unfurrows its brow, smiles, says things are changing-Any spiritual nothing can get upset when things aren't going well; You have to watch about being intense and serious all the time
- D. The joyful faith shout gave God access and the walls came down-Js6:20-It came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted (shout for joy, make a joyful noise) with a great shout that the wall fell down flat
- IV. If the joy and peace isn't there address the lack of faith by 1) Hearing from God-Rm10:17,1Sm1:17 2) Feeding on His Word-Truth Effect-Jr15:16,Lam3:17-25

- D. Unbelief is much more serious than the emotion-The danger isn't having the feeling but the feeling overtaking you and the unbelief that signals
- E. -You don't need fake praise you need real faith
- F. It's not the prayer, the praise, the confession it's what's in the prayer, the praise, the confession (Js5:15)-It's the confidence, joy and peace in it
- G. Singing can help you get in faith
- H. God is looking for faith, because faith gives him access-2ch16:7-Because you have relied on the king of Syria, and not relied on the Lord thy God...9The eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him

  - Α. And her adversary also provoked her sore, for to make her fret, because the Lord had shut up her womb. 7 And as he did so year by year, when she went up to the house of the Lord, so she provoked her; therefore she wept, and did not eat. <sup>8</sup> Then said Elkanah her husband to her, Hannah, why weepest thou? and why eatest thou not? and why is thy heart grieved? am not I better to thee than ten sons?  $^{9}$  So Hannah rose up after they had eaten in Shiloh, and after they had drunk.   - B. Fear, sorrow, anger are the fruit of unbelief and unbelief shuts God out The danger is not the emotion, but what it signals; unbelief
  - C. Ac16:25-And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: <sup>17</sup> The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. <sup>18</sup> And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour. <sup>19</sup> And when her masters saw that the hope of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew them into the marketplace unto the rulers, <sup>20</sup> And brought them to the magistrates, saying, These men, being Jews, do exceedingly trouble our city, <sup>21</sup> And teach customs, which are not lawful for us to receive, neither to observe, being Romans. <sup>22</sup> And the multitude

- F. Live in a dark place-Full of awful things and if you focus on it you get depressed; Peace/joy in believing something good is comin
- G. No one has a greater hope than us-Our peace/joy should be greater
- H. To walk in the peace and joy of the Holy Ghost you have to stop yielding to fear/sorrow/anger and seeing the dangers of them inspires you to stop yielding
- I. For many there's not enough joy and peace in their faith and so there really is no faith
- J. Nm14:1,1Sm1:1,1Kings21:5; Ps5:11-Let all those that put their trust in you rejoice: let them ever shout for joy because you defend (cover) the
- K. He didn't just say don't let your heart be troubled)
- L. If you start believing you'll stop being troubled and start rejoicing
- M. To say don't worry, don't be frustrated, rejoice can be incomplete

- C. There's supposed to be a joy in faith-Ph1:25-Having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith; CJ-I know I will stay on with you in order to help you progress in the faith and have joy in it; CSB-For your progress and joy in the faith
- D. Finish our course with joy-Ac20:24-None of these things move me neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God
- E. There is a peace not understanble-Ph4:7-KJ-CEV-No one can completely understand-GNB-Far behond human understanding-ISV-Beyond anything we can imagine-WEY-Transcends our powers of thought-EX-So great we cannot understand it

II. Rejoice always, let your moderation be known unto all men, be careful for nothing-Ph4:4-Rejoice (full of cheer, calmly happy, glad) in the Lord always (at all times, perpetually, continuous): and again I say, Rejoice. <sup>5</sup>Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand (near). <sup>6</sup>Be careful (troubled with cares) for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Let your moderation be known to all men-ST-Mild (tender, gentle in disposition, kind, compassionate, merciful, not cruel, fierce, rough, angry, calm, tranquil), gentle (mild, meek, not rough/harsh, peaceable-quiet, undisturbed, not agitated); W1828-Calmness of mind; equanimity (calm temper, evenness of mind), restrain of violent passions
  - 1. Let your stance for righteousness be known to all men
- C. Be careful for nothing-Many are weighed down with cares of this life
- D. What you think on has directly affects your peace and joy-Think about all the sin and death and darkness in the world? If it's a concern of yours be careful for nothing and make your request known to God
- E. Be a doer-Rejoice always, let your moderation be known unto all men, be careful for nothing
- F. He learned how to maintain his peace and joy no matter what was happening-I know how to not have things go the way I want and not lose my peace and joy
