I. Your spiritual diet affects your peace/joy-Jr15:16-Thy words were found and I did eat (consume) them and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart (inner man) -CJ-When I found your words I devoured them; your words made me glad, they gave me joy

- The words he ate affected his heart-Ipr15.16 Why Jesus gave them the word when they were

No attention, no consumption-You don't eat what you know, you eat what you give attention to; Knowing what something tastes like is NOT consuming it and knowing what The Word says is not consuming it; And I did eat them-You can find them, know them and not eat them

The words you eat <u>affect the spirit like food you eat affects the body-</u> ▶ Words affect the inner man (The place you're troubled) -Pr16:24-Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones

II. Different words will affect the inner man differently

- Consuming God's words works in us peace and joy-Jn15:11-These things I have Α. spoken unto you that my joy might remain in you and that your joy might be full-Jn17:13-These things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves-Jn16:33-These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace-1Jn1:4-These things write we unto you, that your joy may be full
- Consuming words in opposition to God's works in us fear and sorrow-В. Mt14:30-When he <u>saw</u> (look at, gaze at, turn eyes to) the wind boisterous he was afraid-1Sm17:10-The Philistine said I defy (rail, reproach) the armies of Israel this day; give me a man that we may fight together. 11When Saul and all Israel heard (hear with attention) those words of the Philistine they were dismayed and greatly afraid
- something in those words that is released in you when you There's something—▶consume them-So you can't consume the words and not feel the effect in food that is
 - There are words that if you consume them they'll eat you up inside and you'll feel the effect immediately-Words can't affect you if you don't consume them-2Tim2:16-Shun profane and vain babblings...17Their word will eat as doth a canker-Mt14:30
 - What are you eating? NOT what do you know-There are words you can't eat D. if you want to walk in peace/joy
 - 1. Fear and sorrow are dependent upon a certain diet-You can starve them out by not consuming what the devil says
- III. God's words are life-Pr4:20-My son, attend (give attention) to my words; incline (extend) thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from your eyes (Eye of continuance, paying attention); keep (give heed, retain) them in the midst of your heart. 22For they are LIFE (strength, merry, quicken, stomach empty, one is weak then filled and revived, Ex-Hangry) unto those that find them and health to all their flesh-Jn6:63-It is the spirit that quickens; the flesh profits nothing: the words that I speak unto you they are spirit and they are life

Nutrients in The life/joy/peace in The Word is only released when you consume it-It'll do nothing for you until you consume it

B. The Word works so eat and let it work-Hb4:12-AC-Full of power-DAR-Operative-ERV-Alive and working-GNB-Mighty in operation-CSB-Effective

IV. How to consume/eat God's Words

- A. Find them-What does God say in His Word about your situation-Jer15:16
- B. Give your attention to them-Eyes, ears, mind, mouth-Dt11:18-Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. 19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. 20 And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates-Js1:8-This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate (mutter, utter, ponder) therein day and night; Pr4:21-Let them not depart from your eyes
- C. <u>Stick with it-Day and night</u>, let them not depart from eyes, bind them
- V. Your spiritual diet affects your peace and joy because it affects your faith

VI. Your spiritual diet affects your faith and in turn your peace and joy-Whatever affects your faith affects your peace and joy

- A. Belief, good or bad, comes by hearing-Rm10:17-KJ-So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God-ASV-So belief cometh of hearing
 - 1. More you hear something the stronger your belief gets-Truth effect-Study 1977 Villanova and Temple •3 different times 60 plausible statements some true, some false •20 were on all three lists •1 to 7 how confident they were true •Concerned things they were unlikely to know anything about (First Air Force based was launched in New Mexico) •Results stayed same for non-repeated statements •Confidence of the validity of the repeated statements increased each session •1989,1992,2012 studies confirmed it •Roman statesman Cato closed his speeches with a call to destroy Carthage knowing that repetition would breed agreement •Napoleon said there is only one figure in rhetoric of serious importance namely repetition, whereby a repeated affirmation fixes itself in the mind in such a way that it is accepted in the end as demonstrated truth
- B. Consuming The Word feeds faith stirs joy and peace-Consuming the devil's words shapes your belief and throws you into fear/sorrow-1sm17:10
- C. To survive fear and sorrow are dependent on a particular diet-You can starve fear/sorrow by not consuming what the devil says
- D. <u>Everyday I'm choosing to eat it this</u>-Not legalistic you're eating

God's words put hope and faith in you and provoke joy and peace

- E. It's not your circumstances depressing you it's your diet
 - 1. We're feeding looking for joy and peace to spring up

I. NOTES

- A. Live in a dark place-Full of awful things and if you focus on it you get depressed; Peace/joy in believing something good is coming
 - 1. No one has a greater hope than us-Our peace/joy should be greater

- B. To walk in the peace and joy of the Holy Ghost you have to stop yielding to fear/sorrow/anger and seeing the dangers of them inspires you to stop yielding
 - 1. Rejoice and be glad and you'll these things in their tracks-It's not being fake it's being smart
- I. We are to live in peace and joy-Rm14:17-Rm15:13-The God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost
 - A. Believers are to be glad-Ps32:11-Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are upright in heart-Ps35:27-Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause-Ps40:16-Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee-Ps64:10-The righteous shall be glad in the LORD-Ps68:3-Let the righteous be glad; let them rejoice before God: yea, let them exceedingly rejoice-Ps70:4-Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee-Ps149:5-Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
 - B. There is a joy that's inexpressible-1Pt1:8-Yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable (unutterable, inexpressible) and full of glory; ER-Cannot be explained; GNB-Joy which words cannot express; NTE-Joy that goes beyond anything words can say,
 - C. There's supposed to be a joy in faith-Ph1:25-Having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of faith; CJ-I know I will stay on with you in order to help you progress in the faith and have joy in it; CSB-For your progress and joy in the faith
 - D. Finish our course with joy-Ac20:24-None of these things move me neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God
 - E. There is a peace not understanble-Ph4:7-KJ-CEV-No one can completely understand-GNB-Far behond human understanding-ISV-Beyond anything we can imagine-WEY-Transcends our powers of thought-EX-So great we cannot understand it
 - F. The opposite of this is heaviness-It is oppression of the soul-Js4:9-Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness [sadness, a downcast look of expressive sorrow, gloom, grief, weight, depression of spirit, oppression]
 - G. Wrath is a work of the flesh-Gal5:20-Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies
 - H. Co3:8-But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth;
 - I. Pr24:19-Fret not yourself because of evil men, Proverbs 15:15-GW, Psalm 13

- A. Righteous indignation will push you towards the spirit, it'll directs your ire toward the devil; The wrath of man pushes towards sin and the flesh and pushes your ire toward man
- B. [Th-Reviling-Language of despising]
- C. The devil wants you upset about something all the time and if you practice being upset it'll grow in you
- II. Rejoice always, let your moderation be known unto all men, be careful for nothing-Ph4:4-13
 - A. We are to live in a perpetual state of gladness-Calmly happy
 - B. Let your moderation be known to all men-ST-Mild (tender, gentle in disposition, kind, compassionate, merciful, not cruel, fierce, rough, angry, calm, tranquil), gentle (mild, meek, not rough/harsh, peaceable-quiet, undisturbed, not agitated); W1828-Calmness of mind; equanimity (calm temper, evenness of mind), restrain of violent passions
 - 1. Let your stance for righteousness be known to all men
 - C. Be careful for nothing-Many are weighed down with cares of this life
 - D. What you think on has directly affects your peace and joy-Think about all the sin and death and darkness in the world? If it's a concern of yours be careful for nothing and make your request known to God
 - E. Be a doer-Rejoice always, let your moderation be known unto all men, be careful for nothing
 - F. He learned how to maintain his peace and joy no matter what was happening-I know how to not have things go the way I want and not lose my peace and joy

- <u>2Co 12:9</u> And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- <u>Psa 5:11</u> But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.
- Psa 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his salvation.
- Psa 63:5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:
- Psa 66:1 To the chief Musician, A Song or Psalm. Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands:
- Psa 81:1 To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm of Asaph. Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.

- Psa 89:15 Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.
- Psa 95:1 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.
- Psa 95:2 Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.
- Psa 98:4 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.
- Psa 98:6 With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King.
- Psa 100:1 A Psalm of praise. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.
- <u>Isa 49:13</u> Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted.
- <u>Isa 56:7</u> Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.
- <u>Isa 61:10</u> I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.
- 2Co 7:4 Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.
- **2 Timothy 1:7** For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- <u>James 3:1</u> My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation. For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body. Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body. Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!
