## I. After sin man had two big problems-1. What he became 2. Death

He became a sinner, his nature changed-Rm5:19-By one man's disobedience many were <u>made sinners</u>-Ep2:3-By <u>nature</u> (species, kind) the children of wrath

Watch about focusing too much on the acts of sin; The Big thing was what he became Not what he did

- Being a sinner has to do with your nature NOT your behavior-Ps51:5-1. ER-A sinner before I left my mothers womb; Rm5:19-By one man's disobedience
- Problem was sinful nature not sinful acts-2Co5:21-He has made him to be sin for us who knew no sin that we might be made the righteousness of God
- 3. Blood of animals addressed acts, blood of Jesus addresses nature-Lev4:20-It shall be forgiven them; Hb9:9-Offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience; 13 ... the blood of bulls and of goats ... sanctifieth to the purifying of the **flesh** (what is external) 14 ... the blood of Christ...purge your conscience... **Hb10:1**-Can never with those sacrifices...make the comers thereunto perfect; 14...by one offering he hath <u>perfected for ever them</u> that are sanctified
- Death was the problem-Gn2:17-Rm5:12-By one man sin entered into the world and death В. by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned... 14 ... death reigned from Adam to Moses... 15 ... through the offence of one many be dead, 17 For if by one man's Watch about offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of focusing too the gift of righteousness shall <u>reign in life</u> by one, Jesus Christ.<sup>21</sup>That as <u>sin has</u> much on the reigned unto death even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life acts of sin; The big thing is not
  - Sin is a means to an end for him-Jn10:10-The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life ...
  - 2. Death was the punishment for what he became-Ep2:3-Were by nature the children of wrath (punishment); Rm6:23-Wages of sin is death
  - The force of death passed upon all 3 parts of man-His spirit is 3. dead, when his body dies he goes into everlasting torment so fear of death looms-Rm5:12-Gn3:19-Unto dust shall you return-Mt10:28-Destroy...body in hell-1Co6:9-Unrighteous shall not inherit the Kingdom of God-Mt25:41-Depart from me you cursed into everlasting fire...46everlasting punishment-Hb2:15-Through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage-Hb2:14-Power of death
- II. He became what we became and died for us-2Co5:21, Ga3:13, 1Th5:9-God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain  $\underline{\text{salvation}}$  by our Lord Jesus Christ,  $^{10}$  Who died for us that...we should live together with him
- Jesus came as a man so he could die like men die; Spirit, soul, body-Ph2:6-Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:7But He was made himself of no reputation (YL-Did empty himself), and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: 8 And being found in fashion as a man, a dead he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross; Is53:12-Poured out his soul unto death (the whole of a person, body, breath, mind)
  - Death could not hold him-Rv1:18,Ac2:24,Eph1:19-What is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,  $^{20}$ Which he wrought  $\underline{\text{in Christ}}$ , when he raised him from the dead...
  - He was the first man born again inside, glorified outside-Col:18-The С. firstborn from the dead-Hb1:5,2Cor5:21-Lk24:37-They were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit...39Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as you see me have

raised from spirit, to a living one, from a dead natural  ${\sf B}$  . body to a 👞 glorified

one

- III. We can be made alive-Eph2:1-And you hath he <u>quickened</u>, who <u>were dead</u> in trespasses and sins; <sup>5</sup> Even when we <u>were dead in sins</u>, hath <u>quickened us together with Christ</u>, (by grace ye are <u>saved</u>;) Rm8:29-Firstborn among many brethren
  - A. Our spirits have been made new (seals our eternal location) -2Co5:17,21
    If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature-Mt25:46-The righteous into life eternal
  - B. Our souls are delivered from the fear of death-Hb2:15-Were...
  - Our bodies will be glorified—1Cor15:42—So also is the resurrection of the dead.

    43It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory...44It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body...52...we shall be changed...54So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.55O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? 57But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
    - D. We will be just like him-1Jn3:2-Now we are the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him
