The Hireling

- I. Many see people not receiving and equate that to God withholding Just because a person didn't receive does not mean that God withheld
 - A. He can give us something that us never enjoy the reality of in our life-Don't assume because you are not enjoying that God is withheld it-Nm13:2-Land of Canaan which I give unto the children of Israel
 - B. If someone doesn't receive salvation, did God withhold it?—God's will is clear, He's not withholding it and yet not everybody is enjoying it; Don't blame His sovereignty or mysterious will, don't say God didn't save them, say they didn't receive—2Pt3:9—Not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance—Rm5:18—By the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men—Ti2:12—Grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men—Hb4:3—AC—They shall not enter My rest; and this He said although [His] works had been completed and prepared [and waiting for all who would believe] from the foundation of the world.
 - C. <u>If someone doesn't receive we need to be rooted in the reality that God didn't withhold it-I don't know what happened but He didn't withhold it</u>
- II. The heart of The Father is to give, to help; He is open-handed-Ps145:14
 The Lord upholds all that fall, and raises up all those that be bowed down.

 15 The eyes of all wait upon you; and you give them their meat in due season.

 16 You open your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing. 17 The Lord is righteous (fair) in all his ways and holy (kind) in all his works. 18 The Lord is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. 19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry and will save them. 20 The Lord preserves all them that love him
 - A. God was ready to give but they wouldn't listen so they had problems He wanted to keep them from-Ps81:13-Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways! 14 should soon have subdued their enemies and turned my hand against their adversaries. 16...fed them also with the finest of the wheat...with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee-Pr1:24-I have stretched out my hand and no man regarded
 - B. The enemy endeavors to paint a picture of God with crossed arms and closed hands-God could've done more, should've done more, He didn't all He could do; This is an attack on the nature and character of God
 - C. God doesn't do nothing while His people are being devoured-That's someone who doesn't care-Jn10:11-I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. 12 But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, sees the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and flees: and the wolf catches them, and scatters the sheep. 13 The hireling flees, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep-Am3:12-As the shepherd taketh out of the mouth of the lion two legs, or a piece of an ear; so shall the children of Israel be taken out that dwell in Samaria...
